



Dear Parents,

We are pleased to share that Occupational Therapy screenings are provided at Charlotte Country Day School by Southern Piedmont Pediatric Therapy. Jeanmarie Tommasulo and her associates provide the screenings and subsequent services if needed. The primary emphasis is helping children develop better fine motor, visual motor and sensory motor, and handwriting skills. Jeanmarie and her associates operate independently of Charlotte Country Day and are not employees of the school.

Screenings are brief, 15–20-minute clinical observations to determine if an OT **evaluation** is needed. There will be a fee of \$22 for each screening. After the screening, you will be provided a screening form, which will outline the screening results and any follow up recommendations. Parents will need to follow up with the OT for scheduling and discussion of the screening results. If you choose to schedule OT services for your child on our campus, all financial arrangements will be between you and Southern Piedmont Pediatric Therapy. **OT's are on campus 1-2 days per week. Please anticipate 2-3 weeks for completion of the screening.
