

Summer Bus Rules and Policies

Parents Dropping Off and Picking Up Students

- Obey directions of on-site traffic director and stay in carpool lanes.
- Park only in areas designated at each pickup and drop off point.
- Arrive at the bus stop in time to let children safely board the bus so as not to impede the timely departure of the bus.
- When dropping off students in the morning or picking up students in the afternoon, younger siblings must remain in your control; the church has requested that parents depart parking lots immediately after picking up students.
- Once the bus is in motion departing its location, you may not hinder in any way the departure of the bus. This is for the safety of all students and drivers.

Students Riding School Buses

On the bus, students must observe regular classroom conduct except for quiet conversation. The following rules must also be observed:

- Treat the driver and fellow passengers with cooperation and respect.
- Obey instructions of school personnel while riding the bus.
- Do not extend hands or arms or any other part of the body out of the window.
- Remain seated at all times while the bus is in motion.
- Keep bus clean and sanitary.
- Do not use profane or indecent language.
- Never damage or deface the bus.
- No eating or drinking on the bus.
- Students are encouraged to wear their seat belts.
- There is no pre-assigned seating on the bus.
